## SUMMER STUDENT JOB POSTING:

**Black Mountain Irrigation District** is looking to hire a summer student for 2026.

The successful student applicant will be performing a variety of general labour tasks to provide relief for the crew's seasonal workload. The student will be employed from April/May through August/September (dependent on their availability).

The student will be exposed to a variety of situations that they will encounter as a Water Distribution Operator or Water Treatment Operator, which will provide a good overall learning experience. They will see all aspects of a water distribution system and related treatment facilities.

The bulk of the student's duties will involve manual labour, such as maintaining our properties (weed whacking, mowing) or assisting with repairs (working with other operators, digging, general clean-up of site etc.).

Attached is the job description for the position of Labourer. A summer student is deemed a 'casual' unionized position under the CUPE/BMID Collective Agreement, with the rate of pay set at \$33.78/hour, plus 14% paid in lieu of benefits, sick days and holidays.
